Dear Mr Ecclestone.

Thank you for your letter of 13 May 2024, with suggestions for improving New Zealand's Open Government Partnership (OGP) in 2025.

I note the evidence suggests New Zealanders are far more likely than people in other OECD countries to share optimism that our political system allows them to have a say in what government does.

I do not believe a contestable fund, as the one you suggest, is needed to make government more responsive to its citizens.

My view is that the best thing government agencies can do to demonstrate attention to the concerns of our citizens is to deliver the better results they seek. This includes driving better value for public spending, demonstrating accountability for outcomes and prioritising action over bureaucratic process.

I disagree with your suggestion that a co-created work programme is needed to ensure a responsive government.

I look forward to driving tangible outcomes for New Zealanders with better public service delivery and remain focused on ensuring taxpayers dollars are harnessed to that effect.
